

SPECIAL TROPHY FLING (4 STEPS) *: (see below for rules)

*Special Trophy Fling: "Beginner All Ages" & "Novice All Ages": 1st place award is a trophy, with 2nd through 6th places medals/ribbons (if warranted). This dance does not count towards the class trophy; however, dancers can earn a stamp for their card if they haven't already earned one for the weekend.

*Please note that a lunch break is planned each day; on Saturday it will be after the kilt dances, prior to the costume changes & choreographies; on Sunday it will be after the National dances, prior to costume change to the kilt. Primary Awards will be presented to their class prior to the lunch break.

"CHRISTMAS IN JULY" Choreographies: all choreographies: dance must be Celtic Christmas in theme, using movements primarily from Highland and National dances, Jig, or Hornpipe, with allowances for individual interpretation & variation. The costume(s) must follow the theme & content of the dance.

- Solo Choreographies should not last longer than 2 minutes, 30 seconds, including entrances & exits & setting up & removal of props.
- Duet & Group Choreographies: Emphasis should be placed on teamwork & how well the dancers dance together. The Duet Choreography should not be longer than 2 min. 30 secs for Pre-Premiers, and 3 min. 15 secs for the Open, including entrances & exits. The time length including entrances & exits for the Group Choreographies should not last longer than 4 minutes.
- Music must follow the theme of the dance & may include vocals & percussion. Because it is Christmas-themed, any Christmas carol or song may be used. Please provide a CD, Flash drive or iPod/MP3, or you may also dance to a live piper/musician. If you can email it to me (see 1st page) prior to the Festival, that would be wonderful!
- Props may be used for choreographies, but no live animals may be used. Swords may be used for the Duet & Group (i.e. Double Sword or Broadsword Choreographies to Christmas music, if desired).
- Pre-Premier Solo Choreos includes Beginner through Intermediate classes, & will be divided by class if there are enough entries to do so. Pre-Premier Duets & Groups must consist of all Pre-Premiers & may include Primary dancers. Open Duets & Open Groups have at least one Premier but may include dancers from any dance level.
- No stamps will be awarded & Choreographies do not count toward the class trophy.
- Please list the name(s) of the other dancer(s) in your duet or group on your entry form. Duets or Groups should consist of dancers from one school only, or may be from more than one school, in which case the teacher/choreographer must abide by the 3-month teaching/judging rule.
- FEE: \$5 per dancer per dance.

Competition Rules:

- 1. This competition will be conducted in accordance with R.S.O.B.H.D. regulations. All dance competitors & teachers & parents are expected to comply with the ScotDance USA Code of Ethics.
- 2. The decisions of the Adjudicator are final. Any attempt to talk to the judge during the competition by the dancer or parent(s) may lead to disqualification of that dancer. The dancer must not have taken a workshop or class with the Adjudicator within the previous 3 months.
- 3. Highland dress will be worn in accordance with R.S.O.B.H.D. rules. Dancers must be in full costume to receive awards.
- 4. All dancers must have *in hand* a valid (current, with a **2024** sticker on it!) ScotDance USA, ScotDance Canada or R.S.O.B.H.D. registration card. No entry will be accepted without a current registration number. All dancers must present their Registration Card the day of the competition in order to compete.
- 5. **Entry Deadline:** All entries must be **received** by **Friday**, **July 12, 2024**. Entries are **LATE** if **received** after **July 12, 2024** & will be subject to a *late charge of \$10.00* (& the dancer's name may not be listed on the Results Form!)
- 6. Dancers' gate passes (wrist bands) & all other pre-ordered passes will be available at "Will Call" at the Festival Main Gate. Please pick up your competitor number(s) at the "Competitor Check-In" table at the Highland Dance Stage. Please note: *NO* parents or family members will be allowed in the Main Gate without a ticket. It is recommended that the discounted Dancer Family & Friends tickets be purchased with the dancer entry. Please help support the Highland Dance Competition by purchasing your extra tickets with the dance entries. We like to show the Festival Committee that the Highland Dance Competition *does* bring in spectators!
- 7. Dancers not reporting to the marshalling area when their class is called to dance will forfeit that dance.
- 8. Age groupings will be determined by the number of entries received. Ages will be computed as age on the day of competition. Dancers will compete in reverse order of entry (i.e., "First to Enter, Last to Dance"); the last dancer(s) to enter (register) in each class/age group will be first to dance in that class/age group &, if competing in the Half Tulloch, may also be expected to fill in for later sets, as needed.
- 9. Protests must be made in writing & submitted to the Competition Organizer within 7 days of the event accompanied by a \$25 fee that will be refunded if the petition is warranted.
- 10. **Weekend Entry Fees:** (ScotDance USA-Southwest Region receives \$5 from every dancer entry (excluding Primaries).) Primaries: \$25.00 for 1 day or \$40 for both days (or \$10.00 per dance whichever is less).

Beginners: \$45.00 (or \$10.00 per dance - whichever is less)

Novices, Intermediates & Premiers: \$45.00

All Choreographies: \$5.00 per dance (per dancer).

11. Ticket Sale for Highland Dancers' Family & Friends: \$13 Adults (18-64) (per day)

Payment must be *received* by Friday, **July 12, 2024.** Please see the above note about tickets.

\$8 Teens (ages 11-17), Students with ID, Seniors (65+) (per day)

\$8 Military & First Responders (per day)

Kids 10 & Under Free

Price at the Festival Main Gate: 1-Day Ticket : \$15 Adults / \$10 Teens, Seniors & Military/First Responders

Please note: Parking is \$5.00 per car -- just pay the Attendant when you arrive.

- 12. **Prizes & Trophies**: Awards will be presented at the end of competition (Primary awards will be awarded at the completion of the Primary competition each day). Pre-Premier classes: medals will be awarded to 3rd place (if warranted). **Premier class(es): cash awards: 1st: \$25, 2nd: \$20, 3rd: \$15 (except Choreos).** There will be no trophies awarded at the Primary level. Class trophies will be based on all dances in that session, excluding the Special Trophy Fling & the Choreographies. Special Trophies for 1st in Special Trophy Fling & the Choreographies, & medals/ribbons for 2nd through 6th (if warranted).
- 13. **Dances** will be danced in the order shown on the entry form, unless otherwise announced on the day of the competition.
- 14. **Privacy Disclosure Statement:** Personal data (PII) is collected from the competition entry form and owned by the Elizabeth Celtic Festival & the SouthWest Region for the purpose of performing our duties within RSOBHD and ScotDance USA guidelines. All data is retained for a period of one (1) year at which time electronic records will be deleted and paper entry forms properly disposed.
- 15. **COVID-19:** Masks are encouraged for those unvaccinated as per state and local health guidelines. Current COVID guidelines can be viewed at this link: https://www.elbertcounty-co.gov/254/COVID-19-Information.
- 16. We need volunteers to help set up & take down the stage on Friday & Sunday. Free Festival gate entry for each day volunteered. Please advise Shari if you can help.
